Our restaurant HORVÁTH has been a part of the lively Paul-Lincke-Ufer on the Landwehr canal since 2005.

The excellent, creative cuisine of Sebastian Frank forms the centrepiece of your visit and it is perfectly supported by our cordial service team. This was honoured with one star in the Guide Michelin just one year after Sebastian Frank's arrival in Berlin. The Gault Millau followed in 2012 with 17 points, thereby giving our chef his "3rd hat". The Feinschmecker rates HORVÁTH with 3,5 F. The second star came in 2015, just a year after he and Kessler had taken over the restaurant as owners.

However, far removed from any pomp and ostentation, it is the simple interior of the HORVÁTH that impresses, contrasting with our high-class menu and wines. The wealth of wood and warm light that makes our restaurant a cosy setting has witnessed more than 100 years of gastronomic history. The establishment became famous in 1973, when the Austrian writer and philosopher Oswald Wiener opened the "Exil", which used to be a hotspot for the who's who of the Arts back then. Regulars were Joseph Beuys, Andy Warhol, Rainer Werner Fassbinder, Otto Sander and even David Bowie was a guest quite frequently.

Play. Wilful. Authentic.

Children show us how it's done: Learning while playing, open to new experiences, showing courage. I like it when a winemaker stays true to his style! When he plays with the ingredients, when his wilfulness flouts the logical course of action. Such wines are very authentic. Those are the ones you notice, the ones that aren't typical of their grape. They are clear, have a fine, fruity nose and every now and then you find some barrique where you least expect it.

Sweet wines are characterised by palpable aromas, starting from slightly spicy, through flowery all the way to honey notes. They are the epitome of sensuality, sex for the palate. Their enjoyment is exciting - never dull! They are the perfect way to round off a successful evening.
